
# Feedback survey report IQAC, Jonai Girls' College Session: 2023-24

The IQAC, Jonai girls college has prepared an online Google form of Questionnaire containing 22 numbers of close ended questions and one open ended questions ranging from three point to eight points of rating scale to collect students feedback on overall aspects of academic and non academic aspects of the college. The feedback form has been shared to the departmental whatsapp groups off all semesters via HoD of all concerned departments and instructed the students to respond the same within five days from the date of its upload i.e. 25<sup>th</sup> of December 2024. The feedback form has been responded by total 377 numbers of students representing total eight numbers of departments. The following bar diagram shows that highest 83 numbers of students (22%) from the department of Philosophy, 78 numbers (20.7%) from the department of education, 67(17.8%) of Assamese dept., 61(16.2%) numbers of History Deptt. 51numbers (13.5%) of sociology, 50 numbers (13.3%) of political science, 28(7.4%) of Economics and the least 14 numbers (3.7%) from the department of English has responded. Beside the departments of 7(1.9%) could not been recognized and considered for analysis.


#### 1. Student details a. please confirm your Department 377 responses


#### 1.b. Please confirm your Semester


## 2.Teaching learning and Evaluation. 2.1. How much of the syllabus were covered during the last academic year?


#### 2.2. How well did your teachers prepare for the classes? 377 responses


#### 2.3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? 377 responses


#### 2.4. The teacher's approach to teaching learning process can best describe as <sup>377</sup> responses




2.6. Were your semester examination performances and assignments discussed with you? 377 responses

2.7. Does your college takes active interest in promoting Internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students?





2.9. The college provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.



2.10. Do your teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes?




2.11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with and assigned task to you? 377 responses


2.12. Do your teachers illustrate the concept through examples and applications? 377 responses


2.13.Do your teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges?

2.14.Do the teachers able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome that? 377 responses





2.16. Do your teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences?



2.17. Do your teacher Encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities. 377 responses






2.19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multi media,etc. wile teaching.
