The universities and colleges imparting traditional courses need re-appraisal. Today, disciplines under Social Science and Humanities suffer from innumerable problems in terms of technological support, pedagogical approach, and effective classroom transaction. These disciplines are largely depended on citical theories and criticisms but the co-ordination between the internas of the learned seems to be cripping under extreme unequal terms.
