## Concept Note:

The Ministry of Human Resource Development has been implementing a large number of programmes through its Governmental and Non-Governmental agencies to better mobilization, upgradation and create opportunities for both the learner and the learned for sufficiently long time. Despite the honest attempt on the part of the concerned Ministry and its various agencies, there is still a long way to achieve its goal. The condition of higher educational institutions in India is still deplorable basically in the public sector. There is ever shortage of basic amenities, provisions, infrastructural deficiencies, shortage of man-power and proper training to the teacher community according to the demands of present International standard of education. The traditional classroom, the means and modes of transaction or participation have undergone a drastic change. Simultaneously, the infrastructural set up, especially the classrooms; library and other facilities need re-organization and re-patterning. Most importantly, the pedagogical approach in teaching-learning process urgently requires re-assurance and technological support. However, the fact is that the higher educational institutions of rural India suffer from either expertise or beyond the reach of present practices in the educational system. The traditional curriculum appears incompatible and insufficient at the backdrop of straight paradigm shift. The current practices in conformity with the international mode will obviously give birth to fresh issues pertaining to acute man-power and other provisions. The universities and colleges imparting traditional courses need re-appraisal. Today, disciplines under Social Science and Humanities suffer from innumerable problems in terms of technological support, pedagogical approach, and effective classroom transaction. These disciplines are largely depended on critical theories and criticisms but the co-ordination between the learner and the learned seems to be crippling under extreme unequal terms. Since the present curriculum is gradually turning to interdisciplinary nature, there is ultimate requisition of novel approach to deal with the classroom environment. Otherwise, the higher educational institutions will produce only graduates and post graduates but not well educated generation in true sense of the term. If the higher educational institutions do not become the centre of producing relevant man-power of the present digital world, the entire exercise will be proved futile. It will be merely wastage of money, power and valuable time. Hence, there is strong ground to find spaces where the learner and the learned can meet frequently to design a future road map for the higher educational institutions.

## About the College:

Jonai Girls' College is the only higher educational institution imparting education for women of this sub-division. The college is located in the heart of Jonai Town sharing the border between Assam and Arunachal Pradesh. It is well connected by roadways, waterways and airways. The National Highway 52 is less than 0.5 km distance from the college. There are ferry services from Dibrugarh city via Bogibeel, Oiram Ghat, Panbari and Majorbari within the accessible area of 100 Kilometres. The air service is also available from Mohanbari, Dibrugarh situated at the outskirts of the city.




